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A Creatinine lab test is indicated based on the following risk/screening criteria: If a serum creatinine lab value cannot be referenced from within the last week please complete the risk assessment and order a creatinine lab test if indicated.

Check the appropriate box(s):

- Patient 60 years or older for a CT with contrast, and 50 years or older for MRI with contrast.
- Patient under 60 years old for a CT with contrast **and** under 50 years old for a MRI with contrast and one of the following criteria:
 - Insulin dependent diabetes
 - Previous/current renal insufficiency/disease
 - Only one kidney or kidney transplant
 - Currently using Glucophage (Metformin)
 - Congestive heart failure
 - High blood pressure
 - Currently using Lithium
 - Previous creatinine of over 2.0 (may need to retest on day of examination)
